A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CULBERTSON, MONTANA, DECLARING IT TO BE THE INTENTION OF SAID TOWN COUNCIL TO PASS AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A FRANCHISE TO THE DELTA GAS COMPANY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSTALLING A VAPORIZED NATURAL GAS AND/OR PROCESSED NATURAL GAS DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM FOR THE PURPOSE OF FURNISHING AND SUPPLYING VAPORIZED NATURAL GAS AND/OR PROCESSED NATURAL GAS TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC IN THE TOWN OF CULBERTSON: STATING THE CONSIDERATION TO BE PAID TO THE TOWN OF CULBERTSON FOR SUCH FRANCHISE, DECLARING THAT SAID APPLICATION AND ORDINANCE SHOULD BE VOTED UPON BY THE RESIDENT FREEHOLDERS WHOSE NAMES SHALL APPEAR ON THE TOWN TAXROLL PRECEDING SUCH ELECTION: SETTING FORTH THE MEANS OF AND THE DATES OF GIVING NOTICE OF SUCH ELECTION.
